### CEREMONY MARKS OFFICIAL COMPLETION OF UK'S LARGEST REHOUSING PROGRAMME

Cllr. Janet Ludlow, Mayor of the London Borough of Tower Hamlets, and David Hardy, Chairman of the London Docklands Development Corporation (LDDC), will officially declare the completion of the UK's largest ever rehousing programme on Tuesday, 4 December 1990.

They will unveil a plaque commemorating the successful rehousing of over 500 families, moved to new accommodation to make way for the major Limehouse Link road development in London Docklands. The ceremony will take place in Lukin Street, Wapping.

The Mayor and Mr Hardy will also meet Mr Wadiwalla and his family, one of the 26 families which have chosen to move to the purpose-built housing scheme at Lukin Street.
