The completion of the London Docklands Development Corporation's (LDDC) regeneration remit in Wapping and Limehouse will be commemorated on Friday, 31 January following the official transfer of its responsibilities to the London Borough of Tower Hamlets (LBTH) at midnight, 30 January 1997.

The occasion will be marked by an exchange of gifts by LDDC Deputy Chairman, Lord Cocks of Hartcliffe, and the Mayor of Tower Hamlets, Cllr Albert Jacob at Shadwell Basin, one of the rejuvenated dock areas which typify regenerated London Docklands. The Basin is home to a variety of watersports and wildfowl, and is fringed by attractive housing.
