LDDC HANDS BUSINESS CENTRE BACK TO NEWHAM

Cody Road Business Centre, near Canning Town, will be 'handed over' to the London Borough of Newham at 1.00 pm on Tuesday, 23 September. Sir Michael Pickard, Chairman of the London Docklands Development Corporation (LDDC) and Cllr Connor McAuley, Deputy Leader of London Borough of Newham, will sign a document of transfer and unveil new site signage to mark the occasion.

Cody Road Business Centre is a 50 acre site, located some two miles north of Canary Wharf to the east of the River Lea, which the LDDC acquired in 1983. The land was urgently need by the Corporation to relocate industrial companies from Docklands to make way for vital regeneration schemes including major highway projects improve access links.

Of the original 11 companies that relocated to the site in 1986, nine remain and the total number has now increased to 51 companies employing 1,200 people.
