2. With the successful completion of the LDDC's regeneration task in Bermondsey Riverside, an order was laid in Parliament on 7 October 1994 excluding the area from the Corporation's boundaries from 31 October 1994.
3. From 31 October 1994, Southwark Council will be responsible for development control in Bermondsey Riverside, determining all planning applications lodged from that date. LDDC will have until 31 March 1995 to complete determination of planning applications it receives on or before 30 October 1994.
