### LONDON'S STOLPORT GIVEN GO-AHEAD

The London Docklands Development Corporation (LDDC) today gave Approval of Details for the construction of the terminal building and runway of the short take off and landing (STOL) airport in the Royal Docks.

Outline planning permission was granted to John Mowlem and Company plc by the Secretary of State for the Environment on 23 May 1985 subject to formal Approval of Details.

A condition of the Corporation's Approval of Details is that any additional noise protection measures which the LDDC consider necessary after a further period of consultation with the London Borough of Newham and local residents must be incorporated in the design.

The LDDC has invited comment from the London Borough of Newham and other interested parties on the noise report published on 8 February 1986 by its noise consultant and these comments will be re-presented to the Board.

The LDDC will also be working with local community representatives to establish understanding of the noise report implications and measures to be taken, any present apprehensions about STOLport plans will be resolved.

This approval of the STOLport plans comes after a substantial period of consultation with local residents, authorities and other interested parties (see Note to Editors).

The STOLport is expected to become operational in 1987 and ultimately be able to handle over a million passengers a year travelling to major European and UK business centres.
