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LDDC PLANS FOR REHABILITATION OF EXISTING HOUSING STOCK

The LDDC is committed to the regeneration of the Docklands area and whilst it can make the most positive and direct steps on the land vested in it, the Corporation would like to consider ways and means of older property in the area being upgraded to modern standards for the benefit of existing residents.

The Corporation would wish to contribute to improvements to the external environment of flatted estates in Docklands at the same time as local authorities are refurbishing the structures and internals of the blocks themselves. In mounting a programme of this kind co-operation of the local authority, their tenants and residents is of paramount importance.

The Corporation is keen to receive from Tower Hamlets, Newham, Southwark and the Greater London Council their views on programmes for the refurbishment of existing properties in the Docklands area.
